Each shop has a manager and volunteers to support the shop staff who are employed by Octavia Foundation. It is vital that we have paid staff in the shops as well as volunteers so that we have people with lots of experience helping our customers and the shops are always open for business. Preferably a commitment of a minimum of 3 months for four hours per week	Е

Training & Support

- In order to undertake a voluntary role, training and coaching in the procedures and best practice necessary will be given. These will be clearly set out in the induction to the shop
- Volunteers are expected to be available for an informal catch up support session with either the Shop Manager or the Volunteer Coordinator.
- There will be a probationary period of 4 weeks with a review with the Shop Manager at the end for the benefit of all parties involved.
- Volunteers will support the project by assisting with monitoring and evaluation in terms of visits, feedback and improvement forms.
- Accurate records of volunteer expenses will be maintained and volunteers are
 responsible for returning receipts to the Shop manager. As a volunteer, you will be
 reimbursed the cost you may have incurred in getting to the shop from your home and
 back again, up to the equivalent of a return travelcard, zones 1-4. This might be the
 cost of a bus or train fare. If a volunteer works three hours or more, they are also
 entitled to up to £3.50 for lunch, again on the provision of receipts.

These guidelines outline the main responsibilities of a Volunteer Shop Assistant – The Volunteer Team at Octavia Foundation asks volunteers to undertake them to benefit the volunteer service that we offer.
